4.0 Turning Off Cookies in Different Browsers

The Help menu on the menu bar of most browsers will tell you how to prevent your browser from accepting new cookies, how to have the browser notify you when you receive a new cookie and how to disable cookies altogether. Additionally, you can disable or delete similar data used by browser add-ons, such as Flash cookies, by changing the add-ons settings or visiting the website of its manufacturer.

5.0 Review and Adoption by the Board of Trustees

- 5.1. Bury St Edmunds Women's Aid Centre's Board of Trustees is required to formally adopt this Policy. The Board of Trustees is required to keep a documented record of their decision to adopt this Policy. The Policy's full title and the date it was adopted will be documented in the minutes of that Trustee Board Meeting. This will be the evidence of the decision to adopt this Policy.
